Subject: Request for Approval to Access Other Governmental Entity Contract: Purchase of
Model Year 2012 Police Vehicles

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve accessing a contract that was competitively awarded by the Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) for purchase of Model Year 2012 police patrol vehicles for the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD). Based on pricing, the per vehicle cost is \$1,221 lower under the FSA contract compared to bids received under the County's current Invitation to Bid (9550-0/12). It is therefore in the best interest of the County to access this contract.

However, the cutoff date to place the order under the FSA contract is April 21, 2012. As a result, if approved at Committee, a waiver directly to the April 17, 2012 Board agenda will be required in order to meet this deadline and take advantage of the favorable pricing under the FSA contract. An accompanying item rejecting all bids received for Contract No. 9550-0/12 is also before the Board for approval.

CONTRACT NUMBER: 11-19-0907-MD

CONTRACT TITLE: Pursuit, Administrative Non-Pursuit, Utility Vehicles, Trucks & Vans, and Other Fleet Equipment

TERM: One Year (October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012), as awarded by FSA. The contract will commence on the date the order is placed by the County and will expire on September 30, 2012.

METHOD OF AWARD: Lowest responsible bidder by specification by manufacturer by zone for all police package vehicles.

PRIOR CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$6,473,000 for a one-year period

PROPOSED CONTRACT: \$2,645,000 through September 30, 2012

BACKGROUND

MDPD is requesting access to a Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) contract to purchase 121 model year 2012 police patrol vehicles. FSA awarded this contract under full and open competition for purchase of various types of pursuit and non-pursuit utility vehicles, trucks, vans, and other fleet equipment. These vehicles are equipped with the manufacturer's "Police Packages", which include special engines for high-speed pursuits, upgraded suspensions, cooling systems, and other enhancements. The Office of Management and Budget has approved the replacement of operational police vehicles for MDPD.

The price per vehicle under the Florida Sheriff's Association contract is \$21,853. The price is \$1,221 lower than the \$23,074 price per vehicle received in response to County bid 9550-0/12, which is being rejected.

LIVING WAGE: Services provided are not covered under the Living Wage Ordinance.


USER ACCESS PROGRAM: User Access Program and Inspector General fees were not included in this contract.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCESS OF A FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,657,000 TO PURCHASE MODEL YEAR 2012 POLICE PATROL VEHICLES, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ACCESS THE AGREEMENT FOR AND ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, AND TO EXERCISE ANY CANCELLATION AND RENEWAL PROVISIONS, AND TO EXERCISE ALL OTHER RIGHTS CONTAINED THEREIN CONTRACT NO. 11-19-0907-MD

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board approves the access of Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. 11-19-0907-MD in the amount of \$2,657,000 for the purchase of model year 2012 police patrol vehicles, and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to access the agreement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, and to exercise any cancellation and renewal provisions and all other rights contained therein.


