RESOLUTION NO. R-327-12

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S
DESIGNEE TO STRIPE NW 3RD STREET BETWEEN NW 14TH
AVENUE AND NW 16TH AVENUE TO ALLOW FOR
CERTAIN ON-STREET RESIDENTIAL PARKING
PREVIOUSLY IMPACTED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION
OF MARLINS STADIUM

WHEREAS, residential parking along NW 3rd Street between NW 14th Avenue and NW 16th Avenue in Miami-Dade County, was impacted in connection with the construction of Marlins Stadium and ingress and egress thereto; and

WHEREAS, through a cooperative effort with the City of Miami, a plan was developed to stripe some parking spaces along NW 3rd Street between NW 14th Avenue and NW 16th Avenue, in accordance with Federal, State and County safety and design standards in an effort to mitigate the impact on parking to the residents in this area; and

WHEREAS, April 4, 2012 is the scheduled opening day for the Marlins at Marlins Stadium, thereby necessitating the expeditious implementation of the striping of the parking; and

WHEREAS, the striping of on-street parking along NW 3rd Street between NW 14th Avenue and NW 16th Avenue is in the best interests of the residents in the impacted area; and

WHEREAS, public infrastructure and parking are important components in connection with Marlins Stadium, both to the public and to the Marlins,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board incorporates the prior recitals as though fully set forth herein, and directs the Mayor or the Mayor's Designee to facilitate the implementation of the striping of the parking spaces prior to the opening game at

Marlins Stadium on April 4, 2012, by all appropriate means, including urging the Marlins to pay for, expedite, and stripe the parking spaces on an emergency basis.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro, and the Co-Sponsor is Chairman Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Audrey Edmonson and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
