

RESOLUTION NO. R-427-12

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 97 AVENUE FROM SW 88 STREET (KENDALL DRIVE) TO SW 104 STREET AS "PINEWOOD ACRES AVENUE"

**WHEREAS**, in 1952, DeVille Albury and Lorraine Lones, both teachers in the public school system, made the decision to start a private school on a piece of farmland near South Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, Pinewood Acres School is a prekindergarten to 8th grade school that offers an enriched curriculum, providing the highest standards of intellectual development, physical fitness, and social and emotional growth for students; and

**WHEREAS**, Pinewood Acres students are acknowledged for their academic achievements, appreciation for the arts and the highest values; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 97 Avenue from SW 88 Street (Kendall Drive) to SW 104 Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor Pinewood Acres School, on their 60th year anniversary, with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 7,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 97 Avenue from SW 88 Street (Kendall Drive) to SW 104 Street as "Pinewood Acres Avenue".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the

Public Works and Waste Management Department and Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Xavier L. Suarez. It was offered by Commissioner **Xavier L. Suarez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
