

RESOLUTION NO. R-428-12

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 56 STREET (MILLER DRIVE) FROM SW 67 AVENUE TO SW 72 AVENUE AS "JOSE IGNACIO RIVERO WAY"

WHEREAS, Jose Ignacio Rivero was born in Cuba on October 28, 1920, the grandson of the founder of "Diario de la Marina," Don Nicolas Rivero; and

WHEREAS, in 1960, after the Castro government confiscated the newspaper, Jose Ignacio Rivero left for exile where he continued his journalistic career in Spain and the United States; and

WHEREAS, Rivero received many honors for his dedication to the freedom of the press and was also granted the distinction of Knight of the Holy Sepulcher by the Vatican; and

WHEREAS, Jose Ignacio Rivero passed away in Miami on August 3, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Rivero with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, SW 56 Street (Miller Drive) from SW 67 Avenue to SW 72 Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 7,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 56 Street (Miller Drive) from SW 67 Avenue to SW 72 Avenue as "Jose Ignacio Rivero Way."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the

Public Works and Waste Management Department and Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Xavier L. Suarez. It was offered by Commissioner **Xavier L. Suarez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
