



RESOLUTION NO. R-451-12

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 105TH AVENUE FROM
SW 8TH STREET TO SW 12TH STREET AS "DEACON PEDRO
PABLO CALVO AVENUE"

WHEREAS, Pedro Pablo Calvo was born in Camaguey, Cuba on June 30, 1939; and

WHEREAS, in 1962, he married Rita A. Calvo, and in 1971, they came to Miami, shortly thereafter relocating to Louisville, Kentucky where he commenced his college education while working at an aluminum factory; and

WHEREAS, in 1973, Calvo and his wife Rita returned to Miami to complete his studies, and on August 25, 1978, Calvo graduated from Florida International University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry; and

WHEREAS, since 1986, Calvo and his wife Rita have been parishioners of Saint Agatha Church and have served in the parish program "Cursillos"; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 1994, Calvo was ordained as a Deacon by the Archdiocese of Miami and was involved in the ministry of the Sacrament of Baptism in his parish Saint Agatha; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 1997, Calvo obtained his Master's degree in Pastoral Ministry from Barry University; and

WHEREAS, in 2005, Deacon Calvo was appointed to the Ministry to the Bereaved at Saint Agatha Parish, and is remembered by many parishioners for consoling them at funeral services for the loss of their family members; and

WHEREAS, Deacon Calvo also was appointed by the Archdiocese of Miami to be Spiritual Director of “Rescate”, a program for men and women detainees in jailed at Florida City and South Florida Reception Center; and

WHEREAS, Deacon Calvo died at the age of 68 on April 16, 2007; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Deacon Pedro Pablo Calvo with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, SW 105th Avenue from SW 8th Street to SW 12th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 105th Avenue from SW 8th Street to SW 12th Street as “Deacon Pedro Pablo Calvo Avenue”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
