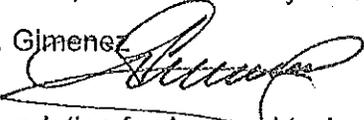

Subject: Recommendation for Approval to Award: Metrorail Parking Permits

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve award of this contract to Lithografikos, LLC. for printing of Metrorail parking permits for Miami-Dade Transit (MDT).

Approval is also requested to allow MDT to use Charter County Transportation Surtax funds as a component of MDT Operating funds for this contract. This contract award recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This award recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Contract Number and Title

IB5770-0/17, Metrorail Parking Permits

Scope

The impact of the item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact and Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the five-year term is \$126,000 and budgeted from MDT Operating funds. MDT has confirmed that no federal funds will be used for this contract. MDT Operating funds include Charter County Transportation Surtax funds. The total allocation for the previous contract was \$166,000 for five years and six months.

Track Record/Monitor

MDT is the user department and the Internal Services Department monitors the contract. Ana M. Rioseco of the Internal Services Department is the Procurement Contracting Officer.

Delegated Authority

Upon approval of this item, the County Mayor or designee will have the authority to exercise, at their discretion, contract modifications, subsequent options-to-renew, and other extensions in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

Due Diligence

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine Contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and that there are no performance or compliance issues. The lists that were referenced include: convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to Contractor responsibility. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution R-187-12.

Applicable Ordinances and Contract Measures

This contract has a Small Business Enterprise Set Aside measure. The Local Preference Ordinance was applied in accordance with the Ordinance. The services being provided are not covered under the Living Wage Ordinance. This contract includes the two percent User Access Program provision which will be collected on all purchases.

Background

An Invitation to Bid was issued under full and open competition on September 2, 2011 for the printing of Metrorail parking permits for MDT. The parking permits are used by patrons of MDT's Metrorail System to park vehicles at Metrorail stations. These permits are sold at supply service centers and sales outlets. Approximately 16,000 permits are sold on a monthly basis. These parking permits generate revenue for MDT and allow Metrorail users to have access to parking.

One responsive, responsible certified Small Business Enterprise bidder offered pricing. Staff negotiated the per-unit pricing offered by the recommended bidder. As a result of negotiations, the County will pay approximately 40 percent (or \$82,000) less than the original proposed price and 22 percent (or \$36,000) less than the pricing under the current contract over the five-year contract term.

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT IB5770-0/17, METRORAIL PARKING PERMITS, TO LITHOGRAFIKOS LLC D/B/A MINUTEMAN PRESS AT THE FALLS IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$126,000 FOR THE FIVE-YEAR TERM, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO MODIFY THE CONTRACT, EXERCISE ANY CANCELLATION AND RENEWAL PROVISIONS, AND ANY OTHER RIGHTS CONTAINED THEREIN, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT, ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SURTAX FUNDS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to award Contract No. IB5770-0/17, Metrorail Parking Permits, to Lithografikos LLC d/b/a Minuteman Press At The Falls, in the amount of up to \$126,000 for the five-year term; authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to modify the contract, exercise any cancellation and renewal provisions and any other rights contained therein, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract, on behalf of Miami-Dade County, and authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds.
