

RESOLUTION NO. R-589-12

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE WRITTEN QUARTERLY REPORTS TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LISTING ALL DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLES SUBJECT TO ADJUSTMENT PURSUANT TO IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-9 THAT ARE IN EXCESS OF \$2,500.00

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2011, this Board approved Implementing Order 3-9 which authorizes the Mayor and department directors to make certain accounts receivable adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Implementing Order 3-9 does not provide for the reporting of these accounts receivable adjustments to this Board; and

WHEREAS, it will be beneficial to have the Board informed, on a quarterly basis, of the name of the account holder and the amount of the delinquent receivable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board does hereby direct the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to provide a quarterly report of aging accounts receivables in excess of \$2,500 that are 90 days or older which shall include the department, amount owed, name of business, and actions taken. The report described herein shall be submitted to the next available meeting of the Board of County Commissioners following the end of each fiscal quarter.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
