

RESOLUTION NO. R-937-12

RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT THE TERM LIMIT RESTRICTION FOR COUNTY BOARD MEMBERS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 2-11.38.2 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND AUTHORIZING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF JAMES A. REEDER TO THE CITIZENS' INDEPENDENT TRANSPORTATION TRUST (CITT)

**WHEREAS**, James A. Reeder has served on the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) with distinction for eight years; and

**WHEREAS**, James A. Reeder has continuously served as an active member of the CITT; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County authorizes a waiver of the eight year term limit for members of County Boards by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the County Commission members present; and

**WHEREAS**, the Miami-Dade League of Cities, who originally appointed James A. Reeder to the CITT, wishes James A. Reeder to serve an additional four year term,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby waives by a two thirds (2/3) vote of the members present the term limit restriction for County Board members and authorizes the re-appointment of James A. Reeder to an additional four year term on the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT).
