RESOLUTION NO. R-966-12

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY & MOTOR VEHICLES TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF MOTORCYCLE LICENSE PLATES OR ALTERNATIVELY TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF LETTERS AND NUMBERS USED ON MOTORCYCLE LICENSE PLATES IN ORDER TO MAKE THEM EASIER TO READ

**WHEREAS**, motorcycle license plates in Florida are currently small and often difficult to read; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida law currently provides that car and truck license plates must be at least 6 inches wide and not less than 12 inches in length, unless a plate with reduced dimensions is deemed necessary by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles to accommodate motorcycles, mopeds, or similar smaller vehicles, pursuant to section 320.06, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles currently issues motorcycle license plates that are 7 inches wide by 4 inches high; and

**WHEREAS**, at the present time, motorcycle license plates in the United States are universal across all 50 states and the District of Columbia at 7 inches wide by 4 inches high, which is similar to car and truck license plates in all 50 states and the District of Columbia which are universal at 12 inches wide and 6 inches high; and

**WHEREAS**, these universal sizes were requested by vehicle manufacturers in order to have uniform mounting brackets and space on vehicles for all license plates across the United States and Canada; and

**WHEREAS**, European automobile and motorcycle license plates are generally larger than U.S. plates; and

**WHEREAS**, European automobile license plates are generally 20 inches wide and 4.3 inches high, while European motorcycle license plates are generally 9.5 inches wide and 5.1 inches high; and

**WHEREAS**, each state has the authority to determine the size of its motorcycle license plates; and

**WHEREAS**, Maryland was the last state to have motorcycle license plates that were bigger than other states at 8.5 inches wide and 4.5 inches high; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2008, however, the Maryland General Assembly passed HB 844 to change Maryland state law to conform the size of motorcycle license plates to the other 49 states and the District of Columbia at 7 inches wide by 4 inches high; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Legislature should require larger motorcycle license plates that are easier to read, or alternatively increase the size of letters and numbers used on Florida motorcycle license plates to make them easier to read,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Urges the Florida Legislature and the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles to increase the size of motorcycle license plates or alternatively to increase the size of letters and numbers used on motorcycle license plates in order to make them easier to read.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation and the Executive Director of the the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles.

**Section 3.** Directs the County’s state lobbyists to lobby for passage of legislation as set forth in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include these issues in the 2013 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board for approval.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Lynda Bell** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
