



RESOLUTION NO. R-1078-12

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF NW NORTH RIVER DRIVE FROM NW
10TH AVENUE TO NW 7TH STREET ROAD AS "GARDNAR
'GAR' MULLOY DRIVE"

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2012 the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-12-0389 which codesignated NW North River Drive from NW 10th Avenue to NW 7th Street Road as "Gardnar 'Gar' Mulloy Drive", in recognition of his contributions to the City of Miami, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Gardnar Mulloy was born in Washington, D.C. on November 22, 1913 but from the early age of two weeks old and all through his life he lived on North River Drive in the historic Spring Garden neighborhood of the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, Mulloy graduated Magna Cum Laude from the University of Miami Law School in 1937 and served in the United States Navy during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Mulloy was taught to play tennis by his father and eventually became an American tennis star, winning over 116 world and national tennis titles, including the U. S. Open, the French Open and Wimbledon; and

WHEREAS, Mulloy was the first American to win the doubles championship title at Wimbledon in 1957, and was presented the Wimbledon Cup by Queen Elizabeth; and

WHEREAS, he is enshrined in eleven tennis halls of fame in the United States; and

WHEREAS, one of his greatest contributions to tennis was advancing the popularity of senior tennis, playing the senior circuit around the world into his 90s; and

WHEREAS, Mulloy will celebrate his 99th birthday this year and still resides in Spring Garden; and

WHEREAS, NW North River Drive from NW 10th Avenue to NW 7th Street Road is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of NW North River Drive from NW 10th Avenue to NW 7th Street Road as “Gardnar ‘Gar’ Mulloy Drive.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the City of Miami Police Department, the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department and the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION, BY A FOUR-FIFTHS (4/5THS) VOTE, CODESIGNATING NORTHWEST NORTH RIVER DRIVE FROM NORTHWEST 10TH AVENUE TO NORTHWEST 7TH STREET ROAD, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "GARDNAR 'GAR' MULLOY DRIVE;" FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INSTRUCT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. By a four-fifths (4/5ths) vote, Northwest North River Drive from Northwest 10th Avenue to Northwest 7th Street Road, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Gardnar 'Gar' Mulloy Drive".

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to instruct the Director of Public Works to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, Miami-Dade County Public Works, and the United States Postal Service.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}

Footnotes:

{1} If the Mayor does not sign this Resolution, it shall become effective at the end of ten calendar days from the date it was passed and adopted. If the Mayor vetoes this Resolution, it shall become effective immediately upon override of the veto by the City Commission.
