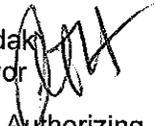

**Subject:** Resolution Authorizing Competitive Contract Modification and Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

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## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached competitive contract modification. The item is described below and in more detail in the accompanying attachment:

**Item 1 – Metrorail Control Center Upgrade:** Modifies this contract for an additional \$916,000 in spending authority to include three modifications to the Metrorail Control Center modernization project.

This contract modification package is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item. The contract in this package is scheduled for the February 2013 CITT meeting.

## Scope

The impact of the item is countywide in nature.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The allocation and funding source is listed in the attached item. The item included in this package utilizes Charter County Transportation Surtax funding.

## Track Record/Monitor

There are no known performance/compliance issues with the vendor in this package. The department's contract manager is reflected in the attached item.

## Delegated Authority

Pursuant to the awarded contract, which was approved through Resolution R-955-11, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise, in their discretion, subsequent options-to-renew periods in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract. This item will authorize an additional allocation for the original contract term.

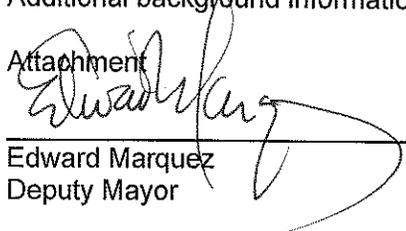
## Due Diligence

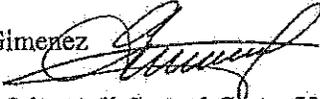

As I will not be sponsoring any award recommendation of this solicitation under the authority of the County Mayor, you should request that any recommended disposition of this solicitation which you deem to be in the best interest of Miami-Dade County be sponsored by a County Commissioner in accordance with the Commission’s Rules of Procedure. I further delegate to you all delegable authority to administer any contract awarded as a result of Contract No. 725 – Metrorail Control Center Upgrade. You should exercise this authority and utilize your own judgment and should take all actions which are in the best interest of Miami-Dade County and consistent with the County Code, regulations, rules and the solicitation documents. Consistent with the Ethics Opinion I will not be participating in any decisions made regarding this solicitation.

**Contract Description and Reason for Change:**

The contract is for the modernization of the Metrorail Control Center (MRCC) at the Stephen P. Clark Government Center. This project includes the development of existing office space to accommodate the modernization of the Central Control facility and systems, new hardware and software, and design and construction of necessary equipment for the control center.

This Supplemental Agreement No. 1 includes the following three modifications to that project:

- Data Transmission System (DTS) Switch Upgrade which will replace the current OC3 Nortel 3300 network system, which is outdated and for which new parts are no longer being produced. The new equipment provides the ability to integrate and connect to existing and future equipment via Ethernet communications. The cost of this modification will not exceed \$298,979.
- Lehman Yard Historical Data Project – Currently, the Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Department does not have any historical tracking of status data such as train locations, switch position, and breaker indications and controls at the Lehman Yard facility. In the event an incident takes place, it is difficult to recreate conditions that were present during the incident to determine the cause of the occurrence. The addition of this modification will provide MDT with the ability to have such data available for any subsequent investigation. The cost of this modification will not exceed \$499,679.
- Fifth Floor Architectural Layout Modification at MRCC – The current configuration of the "War Room" at the MRCC is being modified to improve the Metro Bus area by providing sufficient room for anticipated future growth. The cost of this modification will not exceed \$116,627.

Negotiations of this Supplemental Agreement resulted in a savings of over \$250,000. The proposed pricing for the modifications are based upon rates established in the base agreement.

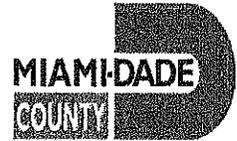
