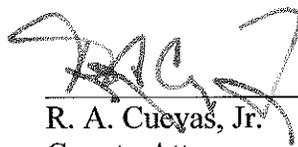

WHEREAS, the Wanna WOD, LLC. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the February 16-17, 2013 "Hero Challenge" in an amount not to exceed \$4,335.75 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

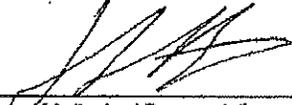

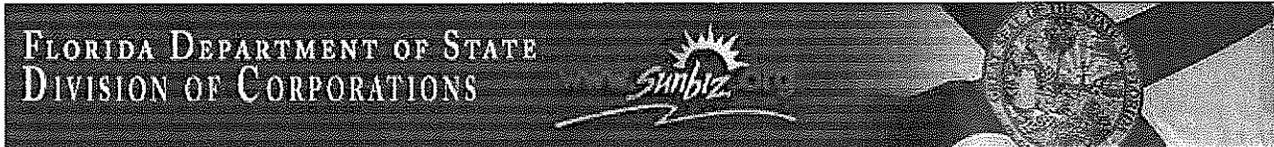
