**Subject:** Request for Approval to Access Other Governmental Entity Contract: Utility  
Vehicles, Trucks, Vans and Other Fleet Equipment

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve this contract award in the amount of \$1,254,961 to Davidson Ford LTD d/b/a Mike Davidson Ford for the purchase of 25 vehicles for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD). The County will be accessing the *City of Tallahassee Contract No. 2518/Mike Davidson Ford* for this one-time purchase. Based on Ford's manufacturing deadlines for 2013 models, waiver of this item directly from May Committee to the next immediate full Board meeting will be requested to secure the favorable pricing offered under this contract. Further, there are no existing vehicles in the County's fleet that could be used in lieu of making these purchases.

Market Research was conducted to compare pricing under the competitive contracts established by the City of Tallahassee, the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA), Florida Sheriffs Association (FSA) and the State of Florida, Department of Management Services. Based on vehicle specifications provided by the user department, quotes were requested from the awarded vendors under each of the aforementioned contracts and analyzed within a price comparison spreadsheet, from which it was determined the awarded vendor under the City of Tallahassee contract offered the best prices on the 18 Ford F-450, two Ford F-150 4x2, two Ford F-150 4x2 XL, and three Ford E-250 models. The City of Tallahassee contract was awarded under full and open competition for purchase of various types of cars and trucks. Additionally, while there were local vendors under the FSA contract, the comparative pricing for this group of vehicles would be approximately \$68,000 higher if the FSA contract was used.

The 25 vehicles will replace existing trucks and vans and will be used as follows: 18 Ford F-450 trucks will be outfitted with cranes to service over 1,000 pump stations; two F-150 4x2s will be used to investigate sewer line problems and accidents; two F-150 XLs will be assigned to the lab division for countywide water and sewage sample collection; and three E-250 cargo vans will be used by air conditioning and refrigeration mechanics throughout WASD locations.

**Scope**

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

**Fiscal Impact and Funding Source**

The fiscal impact for the total one-time purchase is \$1,254,961. These funds are budgeted from the WASD's proprietary funds. There was no previous contract.

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,


