RESOLUTION NO. R-335-13

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING NW 178TH LANE
BETWEEN NW 87TH PLACE AND NW 91ST COURT AS
"STINGRAY WAY"

WHEREAS, Mater Gardens Academy, a charter school, opened in 2006, servicing approximately 850 students in grades K-8; and

WHEREAS, Mater Gardens Academy strives to create a thirst for knowledge in all disciplines, kindle the art of thinking, serve as a springboard for lifelong learning, and deliver and enrich every student with a sense of purpose, a belief in their own efficacy, and a commitment to the common good; and

WHEREAS, the Stingray is the school mascot of Mater Gardens Academy; and

WHEREAS, NW 178th Lane between NW 87th Place and NW 91st Court is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Mater Gardens Academy by codesignating NW 178th Lane between NW 87th Place and NW 91st Court as "Stingray Way"; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates NW 178th Lane between NW 87th Place and NW 91st Court as "Stingray Way."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the

Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
