RESOLUTION NO. R-337-13

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 92ND AVENUE  
BETWEEN SW 40TH STREET AND SW 24TH STREET AS  
"REPUBLICA ARGENTINA AVENUE"

**WHEREAS**, increasing numbers of Argentines are investing in Miami-Dade County, setting up businesses, buying homes, and sending their children to schools in our county; and

**WHEREAS**, South Florida is home to the largest Argentine immigrant community in all of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami's Argentine immigrants have enriched South Florida's multinational tapestry; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County is host to an annual Argentine Festival, held this year on May 1 at Tamiami Park, that draws approximately 20,000 people and features live Argentine music, food, and entertainment; and

**WHEREAS**, Argentine restaurants line the streets of Miami-Dade County, many in County Commission District 10, contributing to our multinational culture and economy; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 92nd Avenue between SW 40th Street and SW 24th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to recognize the contributions of the South Florida Argentine community to Miami-Dade County's economy and thriving multinational culture by codesignating SW 92nd Avenue between SW 40th Street and SW 24th Street as "Republica Argentina Avenue"; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 92nd Avenue between SW 40th Street and SW 24th Street as "Republica Argentina Avenue".

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Miami-Dade County Fire-Rescue Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department and the Development Services Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sen Javier D. Souto**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
