RESOLUTION NO. R-336-13

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 90TH AVENUE
BETWEEN SW 28TH STREET AND SW 32ND STREET AS
“MAJOR GARY SHIMMINGER WAY”

WHEREAS, Major Gary Shimminger began his career with the Miami-Dade Police Department in 1986, serving the Miami-Dade Police Department for over 26 years until his retirement in 2012; and

WHEREAS, during his career with the Miami-Dade Police Department, Major Gary Shimminger held the positions of Officer, Sergeant, Lieutenant, and Captain, before obtaining the rank of Major; and

WHEREAS, during his many years of dedicated service to the Miami-Dade Police Department, Major Gary Shimminger made a significant difference in the lives of many who were fortunate enough to have met him; and

WHEREAS, after retiring from the Miami-Dade Police Department in 2012, Major Gary Shimminger became the Captain of Internal Affairs for the Miami Beach Police Department, where he served until his untimely passing on April 6, 2013 at the age of 55; and

WHEREAS, SW 90th Avenue between SW 28th Street and SW 32nd Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Major Gary Shimminger by codesignating SW 90th Avenue between SW 28th Street and SW 32nd Street as “Major Gary Shimminger Way”; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 90th Avenue between SW 28th Street and SW 32nd Street as “Major Gary Shimminger Way.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sen Javier D. Souto**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
