

RESOLUTION NO. R-381-13

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION NOT TO CLOSE NW 25TH STREET
BETWEEN NW 37TH AVENUE AND NW 42ND AVENUE IN
MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, NW 25th Street in Miami-Dade County is classified as an urban collector road by the Federal Highway Administration, and provides an important connection between NW 37th Avenue and NW 42nd Avenue, which is heavily utilized by local traffic; and

WHEREAS, absent this important connection, local traffic will be negatively impacted by increased congestion in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation and its consultant have expressed an intention and begun steps toward extending a train platform across NW 25th Street in connection with the construction of the Miami Intermodal Center in order to accommodate previously unanticipated larger Amtrak trains; and

WHEREAS, the extension of such train platform would require the closure of NW 25th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation and its consultant are aware of other available and viable alternatives to accommodate the larger Amtrak trains,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Department of Transportation not to close NW 25th Street, and to cause all actions in this regard to cease.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor and to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation.

The Co-Prime Sponsors of the foregoing resolution are Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa and Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Lynda Bell**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
