RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD
CODESIGNATION OF SW 1ST STREET FROM SW KROME
AVENUE TO SW 2ND AVENUE AS "SGT. TONY KOGA III
STREET"

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2012, the Mayor, Vice Mayor, and City Council of the City of Homestead adopted Resolution No. R2012-10-102 which codesignated SW 1st Street from SW Krome Avenue to SW 2nd Avenue as "Sgt. Tony Koga III Street," in recognition of Sgt. Tony Koga III's contributions to the City of Homestead, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tony Koga III began his service as an officer in the City of Homestead Police Department on August 4, 1983; and

WHEREAS, after nearly four years of service, Sgt. Koga III was severely injured in the line of duty during the pursuit of a stolen vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Koga III passed away on March 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, SW 1st Street from SW Krome Avenue to SW 2nd Avenue is a city street located in the City of Homestead; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homestead wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 9,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Homestead codesignation of SW 1st Street from SW Krome Avenue to SW 2nd Avenue as "Sgt. Tony Koga III Street."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Homestead, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Homestead Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Lynda Bell** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, CODESIGNATING SW 1ST STREET BETWEEN SW KROME AVENUE AND SW 2ND AVENUE AS "SGT. TONY KOGA III STREET" IN HONOR OF CITY OF HOMESTEAD POLICE OFFICER TONY KOGA; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tony Koga began his service as an officer in the City of Homestead Police Department on August 4, 1983; and

WHEREAS, after nearly four years of service, Sgt. Koga was severely injured in the line of duty during the pursuit of a stolen vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Koga passed away on March 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Sgt. Koga's brave service to the City of Homestead, the City Council desires to co-designate a street in his name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the above stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed.


Section 2. Street Co-Designation. That in recognition of the outstanding dedication and service rendered by Sgt. Tony Koga to the citizens of Homestead, the City of Homestead formally co-designates, in perpetuity, SW 1st Street between Krome Avenue and SW 2nd Avenue as "Sgt. Tony Koga III Street".

Section 3. Implementation. That the appropriate departments of the City of Homestead are hereby authorized and directed to implement the purpose of this

Resolution by erecting the appropriate street signs, subject to any and all necessary coordination with or approval from Miami-Dade County.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption hereof.
