

RESOLUTION NO. R-633-13

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO PASS LEGISLATION AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ISSUE REGULATIONS TO BAN COMMERCIAL VEHICLES FROM THE LEFT LANE OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE AND OTHER EXPRESSWAYS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED ZONES TO ALLOW SUCH COMMERCIAL VEHICLES SAFE ACCESS TO LEFT-LANE EXITS OR OTHER TURNPIKE OR EXPRESSWAY FACILITIES

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's expressways provide vital transportation links for residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's expressways, including but not limited to Florida's Turnpike, Florida's Turnpike Homestead Extension, I-95 and I-75 are some of the busiest expressways in Florida; and

WHEREAS, the orderly and efficient flow of traffic is of utmost importance to the safety and economic activity of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, numerous studies have shown that banning large commercial vehicles requiring a commercial drivers' license in the State of Florida (collectively referred to herein as "Commercial Vehicles") from traveling in the left lane of expressways improves the flow of traffic and promotes safety in all the lanes of travel on an expressway; and

WHEREAS, these Commercial Vehicles include but are not limited to large truck-tractor vehicles, truck semitrailers, concrete mixing/transportation trucks, large delivery/box trucks, and large three-axle or more commercial trucks; and

WHEREAS, portions of expressways within Miami-Dade County have benefited from regulations in the past that prohibit certain categories of Commercial Vehicles from travel in the left lane of such expressways; and

WHEREAS, to promote uniformity and safety and to maximize the flow of traffic in Miami-Dade County, the Florida Legislature should pass legislation prohibiting Commercial Vehicles from traveling in the left lane of any expressway in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation should issues rules and regulations prohibiting Commercial Vehicles from traveling in the left lane of any expressway within its jurisdiction in Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature to pass legislation to ban Commercial Vehicles from the left lane of Florida's Turnpike and other expressways in Miami-Dade County except in designated zones to allow such Commercial Vehicles safe access to left-lane exits or other Turnpike or expressway facilities.

Section 2. Urges the Florida Department of Transportation to issue rules and regulations to ban Commercial Vehicles from the left lane of Florida's Turnpike and other expressways in Miami-Dade County except in designated zones to allow such Commercial Vehicles safe access to left-lane exits or other Turnpike or expressway facilities.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation, Senate President, House Speaker, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

Section 4. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the legislation set forth above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2014 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Lynda Bell**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
