

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 84 STREET FROM SW  
54 AVENUE TO SW 57 AVENUE AS "OLLA WAY" IN  
HONOR OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES ACADEMY

**WHEREAS**, Our Lady of Lourdes Academy ("OLLA") was founded in 1963, and for the past 50 years has been educating young women in this community; and

**WHEREAS**, Lourdes Academy is among the top 50 Catholic High Schools in the United States and has been named as a Blue Ribbon School of Excellence, making it well-known for its academic and athletic programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission of Lourdes Academy is to educate young women by providing for their spiritual, intellectual, moral and physical development; and

**WHEREAS**, Lourdes Academy graduates have excelled in their chosen professions and as community leaders, and among its notable alumnae are singer Gloria Estefan, Senator Anitere Flores, Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit Court of Florida Bertila Soto and news anchor Maggie Rodriguez; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 84 Street from SW 54 Avenue to SW 57 Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor Our Lady of Lourdes Academy with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed co designation is located in County Commission District 7,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 84 Street from SW 54 Avenue to SW 57 Avenue as "OLLA WAY" in honor of Our Lady of Lourdes Academy.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
