RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S
DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE TO THIS BOARD A REPORT
DISCLOSING THE COSTS INCURRED BY THE COUNTY IN
RE-ADVERTISING COUNTY CONTRACTS DURING THE
LAST TWELVE MONTHS

WHEREAS, every year the County re-advertises a number of contracts before award; and

WHEREAS, the re-advertisement of these items has a financial impact on the County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to be informed of what the costs are to the County of
having to re-advertise such items,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board directs the
Mayor or Mayor's designee to prepare a report disclosing the costs incurred by the County in re-
advertising contracts during the last twelve months. For purposes of this resolution, contracts
include but are not limited to all purchases of goods and services, including professional services
and leases. However, the contracts covered by this resolution are limited to purchases that are
estimated in value to be over two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000). The Mayor or
Mayor's designee is further directed to provide a copy of this report to this Board within sixty (60)
days.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa. It was offered
by Commissioner **Xavier L. Suarez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded
by Commissioner **Lynda Bell** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
