

RESOLUTION NO. R-249-14

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S
DESIGNEE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ANALYZING THE
ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF ART AND CULTURAL EVENTS
ON MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, every year a number of Art and Cultural events, such as Art Basel, take place in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, these Art and Cultural events, and the tourism that they attract, have an economic impact on the community of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the County is a source of funding for many of these events; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to evaluate the economic impact that these events have on Miami-Dade County in light of the funding that the County provides for these events,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the Mayor or Mayor's designee to conduct a study analyzing the economic impacts that Arts and Cultural events have on Miami-Dade County. The study should include the amount of funding that the County provides for these events. The Mayor or Mayor's designee is further directed to present the findings of this study to this Board within sixty (60) days of the date of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
