

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE SEPTEMBER 21, 2013 "HISPANIC HERITAGE FESTIVAL" SPONSORED BY HISPANIC COALITION CORP. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,363.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 1 FY 2013-14 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Hispanic Coalition Corp. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the September 21, 2013 "Hispanic Heritage Festival" in an amount not to exceed \$4,363.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "Hispanic Heritage Festival" is to commemorate Hispanic culture and educate the community; and

WHEREAS, this event will include free music, art, food and entertainment; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Coalition Corp. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "Hispanic Heritage Festival" is a district event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$4,363.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 1 FY 2013-14 In-Kind Reserve Fund,


