## Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Internally Illuminated Street Name Signs Installation* (Project MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20130223) in the amount of \$200,655.52 to Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

## Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes illuminated street name sign installations at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$200,655.52 and will be funded from the Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds. The base contract amount is \$167,996.00, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for traffic signs is included under Traffic Signals and Signs Operations in the PTP Countywide Neighborhood Improvements. The funding index code for this Project is, CPEPTP700SGN.99111 (FY 2012-13 Adopted Capital Project No. 603970).

## Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

**Track Record/Monitor**

Union Electrical Contractor, Inc. has not performed work for PWWM; however, the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database lists 19 awarded construction contracts as follows:

- three (3) from Aviation,
- one (1) from the Public Housing and Community Development,
- one (1) from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces,
- one (1) from the Water and Sewer, and
- 13 from Internal Services.

The referenced database also lists a total of four (4) contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of 3.0 (satisfactory performance), out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., Company Principal is: Jose D. Ruiz and the Company's address is listed as: 2825 SW 79 Court, Miami, Florida 33155.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is PTP Coordinator, Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Julio Navarro, Project Manager, for day-to-day responsibilities.

**Background**

This recommendation for award replaces a contract for which all bids were rejected by the BCC on July 2, 2013 through Resolution R-574-13. The rejection of all bids and withdrawal of legislative item No. 121943 were as a result of delays caused by the need for PWWM to research concerns raised by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local Union regarding the lowest bidder meeting Miami-Dade County's business licensing requirements (e.g., Certificates of Occupancy and Certificates of Use). PWWM worked with the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department and the County Attorney's Office, and found that the lowest bidder submitted a responsive and responsible bid. However, given the time since bids were submitted, and the above determination was made, the lowest bidder requested to be released from the project on account of being notified by suppliers that prices for materials had risen. Rather than placing a CSBE contractor in a position where they may not be able to deliver services to the County, the original project was cancelled, all bids were rejected, and this project was re-advertised and is recommended for approval.

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7040 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards a Request for Price Quotation, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of pre-qualified Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) contractors for the respective trade.

Additionally, all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM staff determined that the scope of work for this project qualified for a CSBE set-aside (Levels I, II, and III). A Community Workforce Program Goal was deemed not applicable to this RPQ. On October 17, 2013, PWWM forwarded RPQ No. 20130223, utilizing the MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07 Contract, to a list of 43 pre-qualified firms. A total of three (3) firms purchased contract documents and four (4) firms proffered a bid.

On November 8, 2013, Union Electrical Contractor, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$167,996.00, three (3) percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, PYD Electric Corp., proffered a base bid of \$191,700.00, 11 percent above the County's cost estimate. The third lowest bidder, Statewide Electrical Services, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$194,304.00, 12 percent over the County's cost estimate.

Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWM issued a recommendation for award on November 20, 2013 for RPQ No. 20130223 to Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, tools and equipment required to provide the installation of internally illuminated street name signs at designated sites within Miami-Dade County. The work includes sign installation as well as the removal of existing overhead signs, and the relocation of existing signal heads and signs in conflict with the proposed scope of work as directed by the Engineer.

Since the inception of the program, internally illuminated street name signs have been installed at over 1,800 intersections throughout the County. Through this contract, PWWM will complete the installation of internally illuminated street name signs at all eligible signalized intersections (excludes spanwire, substandard traffic signal support systems, and locations identified by Municipalities for exclusion).

This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Friday, November 8, 2013. The total RPQ amount is for two hundred thousand six hundred fifty-five dollars and fifty-two cents (\$200,655.52). This includes a base contract amount of one hundred sixty-seven thousand nine hundred ninety-six dollars and zero cents (\$167,996.00), a contingency amount of sixteen thousand seven hundred ninety-nine dollars and sixty cents (\$16,799.60), and dedicated allowances totaling fifteen thousand eight hundred fifty-nine dollars and ninety-two cents (\$15,859.92). The contract duration is established as 120-calendar days. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7040 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The original attached documents must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).
2. Letter from Bonding Agent granting Miami-Dade County authorization to date the Performance Bond.
3. Copies of current insurance certificates.
4. Copies of required license(s).

The preceding documents are required as outlined within Contract MCC 7040 Plan and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded.

Subsequent to the review and approval of the aforementioned documents, you are required to obtain the required permits in the time stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s), a copy(s) must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work.

No work is to be performed without a permit unless the Project Manager issues a written directive to proceed without permit(s).

This letter will also serve as a reminder that all work must be performed according to the scope of work and contract's terms and conditions, all permits and inspections and in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, codes and regulations.

Additionally, this contract, along with any future contracts awarded to your firm, have very similar completion scheduled and competing deadlines. Please be advised that your firm must have the resources to ensure work proceeds without delay once the "Notice to Proceed" is issued. Lack of equipment, personnel or additional contracts with similar completion schedules, will not be reason for delay.

Further, it shall be understood that since proceeds from the Charter County Transportation System Sales Surtax levied pursuant to Section 29.121 of the Code of Miami-Dade County may be used to pay for all or some part of the cost of this contract, no award of this contract shall be effective and thereby give rise to a contractual relationship with the County unless and until the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and the County Commission have approved the award of the contract, and such award becomes final (either by expiration of 10 days after such award without veto by the Mayor, or by Commission override of a veto).
