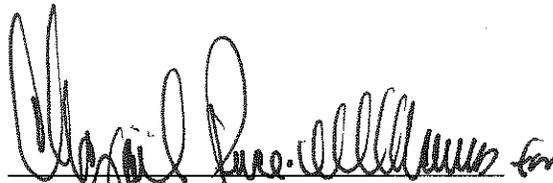

RESOLUTION NO. R-269-14

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING NW 2ND AVENUE
FROM NW 3RD STREET TO NW 14TH STREET AS
“CLARENCE PITTMAN, JR. WAY”; URGING THE
CITY OF MIAMI TO JOIN IN THIS CODESIGNATION

WHEREAS, Clarence Pittman, Jr. was a native of Miami and a graduate of Booker T. Washington, and an alumnus of Central State University in Wilberforce, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Pittman joined the International Longshoremen’s Association Local #1416 in 1957 and served in multiple capacities during his time with the union, including Vice President of the ILA’s South Atlantic and Gulf Coast District and First Vice President Emeritus of the A. Phillip Randolph Institute’s Miami-Dade chapter; and

WHEREAS, in 1982 Pittman became President of ILA Local #1416, as only the third president in the union’s 77-year history, and served as president for over 31 years; and

WHEREAS, the ILA Local #1416 provides job opportunities for thousands of local workers at the PortMiami loading and unloading cruise ships; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service to the union, Pittman also contributed generously to numerous charities, community projects and organizations within his community; and

WHEREAS, Clarence Pittman, Jr. died on December 12, 2013 at the age of 80; and

WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Gwendolyn Willar Pittman, six children, 15 grandchildren, two great-grandchildren, and two nephews; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Clarence Pittman, Jr. by codesignating NW 2nd Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 14th Street as “Clarence Pittman, Jr. Way;” and

WHEREAS, the Union Office for ILA Local #1416 is located at 816 NW 2nd Avenue in Miami, Florida; and

WHEREAS, NW 2nd Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 14th Street is a County road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 3,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates NW 2nd Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 14th Street as “Clarence Pittman, Jr. Way.”

Section 2. Urges the City of Miami to join in this codesignation.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the City Manager of the City of Miami, the City of Miami Police Department, the City of Miami Fire Rescue Department, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, and the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson.

It was offered by Commissioner **Audrey Edmonson**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
