RESOLUTION NO. R-370-14

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S  
DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE MONTHLY REPORTS TO THE  
BOARD REGARDING THE ACTIVITIES OF  
NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE TEAMS

**WHEREAS**, Neighborhood Resource Teams are multidisciplinary units which provide many important services in underprivileged and underserved sectors of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, Neighborhood Resource Team members include police officers, housing officials, public health officials, and social workers who work together to cut red tape and assist in quickly providing access to government resources to those who most need them; and

**WHEREAS**, Neighborhood Resource Teams provide both family-centered intervention, including family assessments and responding to emergency needs, and community-wide intervention, including community-oriented policing principles and channeling tenants' energies into maintenance and clean-up efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure both proper resource allocation, and that community needs are being met, it is important for this Board to be kept apprised of the Neighborhood Resource Teams' activities on a monthly basis,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Directs the Mayor or Mayor's designee to provide a detailed monthly report to this Board on the activities of the Neighborhood Resource Teams. Such report shall be transmitted directly to the members of this Board by memorandum on a monthly basis, with a copy to the Clerk of the Board.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a copy of the reports received pursuant to this Resolution on a monthly basis to any community group as may be subsequently requested by any Commissioner.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Lynda Bell** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
