RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION, AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE MARCH 8, 2014 "35<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ST. PATRICK'S DAY FESTIVAL" SPONSORED BY ST. PATRICK'S DAY COMMITTEE, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,750 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 7 FY 2013-14 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

**WHEREAS**, St. Patrick's Day Committee, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the March 8, 2014 "35<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Day Festival" in an amount not to exceed \$1,750 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the "35<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Day Festival" is a traditional Celtic celebration where family-oriented entertainment will be showcased by Irish singers and dancers and; and

**WHEREAS**, a wide variety of Irish crafts will be showcased, and those in attendance will have the opportunity to enjoy traditional food and beverages; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Patrick's Day Committee, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the "35<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Day Festival" is a special event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,750 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 7 FY 2013-14 In-Kind Reserve Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the March 8, 2014 "35<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Day Festival" sponsored by St. Patrick's Day

Committee, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,750 to be funded from the balance of District 7 FY 2013-14 In-Kind Reserve Fund.






