RESOLUTION DIRECTING MAYOR OR MAYOR'S
DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A MONTHLY WRITTEN REPORT
AS TO THE STATUS OF THE ILLUMINATION OF BUS
PASSENGER SHELTERS LOCATED WITHIN MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY

WHEREAS, illuminated bus passenger shelters provide greater comfort and security for Miami-Dade Transit patrons; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to remain informed as to the progress of efforts to provide illuminated bus passenger shelters,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor or Mayor's designee is directed to provide a ~~[[weekly]]~~¹ >>monthly<< written report as to the status of the illumination of bus passenger shelters located within ~~[[Commission-District-10]]~~ >>Miami-Dade County<<. The Mayor or Mayor's designee is further directed to identify in the ~~[[weekly]]~~ >>monthly<< report which bus passenger shelters within ~~[[Commission-District-10]]~~ >>Miami-Dade County<< are illuminated and which bus passenger shelters are not illuminated.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
