RESOLUTION NO. R-543-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COMMEMORATIVE
DISPLAY IN THE LOBBY OF THE STEPHEN P. CLARK
CENTER HONORING THE MEMORY OF THOSE VETERANS
WHO FOUGHT IN THE ALLIED FORCES' INVASION OF
NORMANDY ON JUNE 6, 1944, AND RECOGNIZING JUNE 6,
2014 AS THE 70TH ANNIVERSARY OF D-DAY

WHEREAS, June 6, 2014, is the 70th anniversary of the Allies' invasion of Normandy, France on June 6, 1944, more commonly known as "D-Day"; and

WHEREAS, D-Day was the largest amphibious invasion in the history of modern warfare, which marked the beginning of the liberation of Western Europe from Nazi occupation during World War II; and

WHEREAS, on this historic day, almost seventy years ago, thousands of American soldiers made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their country and in the defense of freedom; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is home to thousands of veterans who wish to commemorate the patriotism and sacrifice demonstrated by their fallen comrades almost seventy years ago on the beaches of Normandy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor is hereby directed to work with the County's Military Affairs Board and the Stephen P. Clark Center Building Manager to install a temporary display in the lobby of the Stephen P. Clark Center, during the month of June, commemorating June 6, 2014 as the 70th Anniversary of D-Day and honoring the memory of veterans of all branches of the United States' Armed Forces,

as well as from the militaries of our Allies, who fought in the invasion of Normandy, France on June 6, 1944, known as D-Day.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
