RESOLUTION NO. R-639-14

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR THE CREATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A SYSTEM TO ALLOW PAYMENT OF LIBRARY FINES, RENTALS, AND OTHER FEES THROUGH THE LIBRARY'S INTERNET SITE

WHEREAS, providing accessible library services is an important public policy; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Public Library System ("Library") provides library services to Library patrons within the Library Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, facilitating the efficient payment of fines, rental payments, and other library fees will increase the collection rate of such fees and enable library patrons, particularly those with disabilities, to pay such fees more easily and conveniently; and

WHEREAS, the fee schedule for overdue Library materials, use of meeting space at Library facilities, rental of Library equipment, and other Library services ("Library Fees") is set forth in Implementing Order 4-97 approved by the Board of County Commissioners in the Fiscal Year 2014-15 Budget Ordinance and effective October 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Library Fees set forth in the fee schedule are assessed and collected by the Library; and

WHEREAS, the Library currently maintains an integrated software system that tracks, among other things, circulation records, the due dates for lent Library materials, the inventory of Library materials, and the Location of Library inventory; and

WHEREAS, subject to software licensing restrictions, requirements and/or purchases, as well as technical limitations, the software system used by the Library may be able to be modified by County staff and/or the current software provider, or, alternatively another system developed, to allow for online payment of Library Fees; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no system option allowing Library patrons to pay Library Fees online; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a user-friendly countywide online payment option for Library patrons will facilitate the efficient collection of payments and be a convenient, accessible method of payment for Library patrons; and

WHEREAS, such an online payment option should be created and implemented for the benefit of Library patrons and the Library; and

WHEREAS, optimally, the online payment option could be paired and integrated with a smartphone application that would be designed to enable Library patrons to easily and expeditiously make Library Fee payments to the Library using their smartphone devices,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA that the Mayor or the Mayor's designee is hereby directed to develop a plan for the creation and implementation of a user-friendly online payment system for all library fines, rental payments, and other fees described in Implementing Order 4-97 or in other Library rules, and, if feasible, a compatible smartphone application, accessible by the public. The plan should address the timing, capabilities, method of implementation, and costs associated with the creation and implementation of this online payment system. The Mayor or the Mayor's designee shall develop and present such plan to this Board for review within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Juan C. Zapata. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
