RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 5, 2014 "CABA 5K LAWYERS ON THE RUN" EVENT SPONSORED BY THE CUBAN AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION PRO BONO PROJECT, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 7 FY 2013-14 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Cuban American Bar Association Pro Bono Project, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the April 4, 2014 "CABA 5K Lawyers on the Run" in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "CABA 5K Lawyers on the Run" event is to raise funds to benefit the underprivileged members of the community including, but not limited to, the elderly, the disabled, women and children throughout Miami-Dade County; and
