RESOLUTION NO. R-644-14

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE ROAD
CODESIGNATION OF U.S. 1/STATE ROAD 5/SOUTH DIXIE
HIGHWAY BETWEEN S.W. 296 STREET AND S.W. 288
STREET AS "LOURDES GUZMAN-DEJESUS STREET"

WHEREAS, during the 2014 regular session, the Florida Legislature enacted Senate Bill 820, which among other codesignations, codesignated U.S. 1/State Road 5/South Dixie Highway between S.W. 296 Street and S.W. 288 Street as "Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus Street"; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus was fatally shot and killed by a fellow student on November 20, 2012 on a school bus near Homestead while on her way to school; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus was 13 years old at the time and loved music, dancing and art; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus is survived by her mother and three siblings; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of state road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

WHEREAS, U.S. 1/State Road 5/South Dixie Highway between S.W. 296 Street and S.W. 288 Street is a state road located within unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the "Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus Street" road codesignation, Miami-Dade County is required to pass a resolution in support of this road codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the state road codesignation of U.S. 1/State Road 5/South Dixie Highway between S.W. 296 Street and S.W. 288 Street as "Lourdes Guzman-DeJesus Street".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Zoning and Platting Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

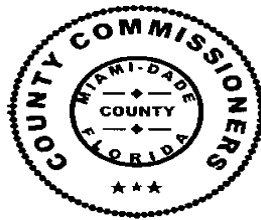
