Subject: Setting of Proposed FY 2014-15 Library District Millage Rate

At the Board's meeting of July 15, 2014, the Board amended the item to set the Library District millage rate at 0.2840 mills for use in preparing the "Notice of Proposed Property Taxes" to be mailed to all property owners in August. The millage rate adopted by the Board will generate \$51.924 million for the Library District.

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve the Library District millage rate of 0.2380 mills, as proposed in my FY 2014-15 Proposed Budget, for use in preparing the "Notice of Proposed Property Taxes" to be mailed to all property owners in August.

**Scope**

State law requires that all property owners be advised of proposed property taxes along with notification of public budget hearings. The Property Appraiser will mail required notices to all property owners in August using proposed tax rates adopted by all taxing authorities in Miami-Dade County.

**Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**


The millage rate recommended will generate \$43.534 million for the Library District.

 LIBRARY DISTRICT OPERATING MILLAGE RATE

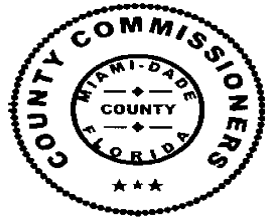
**WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires that within 35 days of certification of value each taxing authority advise the property appraiser of its proposed millage rate and rolled-back rate and of the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rates and tentative budget so that the information can be included in the notice of proposed property taxes mailed to property owners in August and also establishes and describes the requirement that the governing body of each taxing authority hold public hearings on the tentative budget and proposed millage rates,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the proposed FY 2014-15 Library District operating millage rate equal to 0.2840 is approved for transmittal to the Property Appraiser.
