RESOLUTION NO. R-794-14

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING NW 7TH STREET BETWEEN NW 17TH AVENUE AND NW 22ND AVENUE AS "REGIS HOUSE WAY"; URGING THE CITY OF MIAMI TO JOIN IN THIS CODESIGNATION

WHEREAS, Regis House, Inc. is a non-profit, 501(c)(3), charitable, community-based organization with the mission to improve lives for a healthy community through mental health, family support and substance abuse services; and

WHEREAS, Regis House was founded in May of 1984 by Father Francisco Perez-Lerena, a teacher at Belen Jesuit Preparatory School; and

WHEREAS, since its inception, Regis House has served more than 70,000 families throughout Miami-Dade County, providing psychiatric and mental health services, substance abuse services, trauma informed care, individual, group, and family counseling/therapy, school-based prevention programs, public assistance programs, and other valuable programs and services; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the contributions of Regis House to the Miami-Dade community by codesignating NW 7th Street between NW 17th Avenue and NW 22nd Avenue as "Regis House Way"; and

WHEREAS, the Main Office for Regis House is located at 2010 NW 7th Street in Miami, Florida; and

WHEREAS, NW 7th Street between NW 17th Avenue and NW 22nd Avenue is a County road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates NW 7th Street between NW 17th Avenue and NW 22nd Avenue as "Regis House Way".

Section 2. Urges the City of Miami to join in this codesignation.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the City Manager of the City of Miami, the City of Miami Police Department, the City of Miami Fire Rescue Department, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, and the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Bruno A. Barreiro**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
