

RESOLUTION NO. R-859-14

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING N.E. 26 AVENUE/WEST DIXIE HIGHWAY FROM N.E. 186 STREET/MIAMI GARDENS DRIVE TO N.E. 190 STREET AS "COACH BLATCH STREET"

**WHEREAS**, Gregory "Coach" Blatch was born and raised in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, he graduated from Miami Central High School and Florida A&M University, where he received a degree in science and physical education; and

**WHEREAS**, Coach Blatch taught physical education to thousands of Miami-Dade County students for 34 years at Ojus Elementary School, which is located at 18600 West Dixie Highway in North Miami Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to teaching physical education, Coach Blatch ran the safety patrol, planned school theme days including Field Day and often sang in the school talent show; and

**WHEREAS**, Coach Blatch passed away at age 61 from a heart attack; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to recognize the memory of Coach Blatch and his contributions to this community by codesignating N.E. 26 Avenue/West Dixie Highway from N.E. 186 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to N.E. 190 Street adjacent to Ojus Elementary School as "Coach Blatch Street"; and

**WHEREAS**, N.E. 26 Avenue/West Dixie Highway from N.E. 186 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to N.E. 190 Street is a County road located within unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board’s Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed codesignations of Miami-Dade County roads shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road is located; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 4,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates N.E. 26 Avenue/West Dixie Highway from N.E. 186 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to N.E. 190 Street as “Coach Blatch Street.”

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
