

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 102ND AVENUE  
FROM SW 56TH STREET/MILLER DRIVE TO SW 72ND  
STREET/SUNSET DRIVE AS "KYAN BRAXTON QUINTANA  
WAY"

**WHEREAS**, Kyan Braxton Quintana was born on June 30, 2010 in Miami-Dade County;  
and

**WHEREAS**, at the age of two, Kyan tragically drowned in his home pool on June 9,  
2013; and

**WHEREAS**, Kyan was the middle child of five children; and

**WHEREAS**, Kyan attended Smart Starts Day School, where he was beloved for his  
dancing ability and good-nature; and

**WHEREAS**, Kyan's parents, Juan Carlos Quintana and Trudy Quintana, founded the  
non-profit organization Kyan's Kause, devoted to teaching proper water safety awareness  
throughout South Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Kyan Braxton Quintana by  
codesignating SW 102nd Avenue from SW 56th Street/Miller Drive to SW 72nd Street/Sunset  
Drive as "Kyan Braxton Quintana Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 102nd Avenue from SW 56th Street/Miller Drive to SW 72nd  
Street/Sunset Drive is a County road located within unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Rule 9.02 of the Board's Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions  
regarding proposed codesignations of Miami-Dade County roads shall be sponsored by the  
district commissioner where the road is located; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,  
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 102nd Avenue from SW 56th Street/Miller Drive to SW 72nd Street/Sunset Drive as “Kyan Braxton Quintana Way”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
