RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF SWEETWATER
CODESIGNATION OF SW 104TH COURT FROM WEST
FLAGLER STREET TO SW 4TH STREET AS "AVENIDA
NICARAGUA"

WHEREAS, on October 3, 1994, the Mayor and Council of the City of Sweetwater adopted Resolution No. 2254, which codesignated SW 104th Court from West Flagler Street to SW 4th Street as "Avenida Nicaragua", in recognition of the contributions Nicaraguans have made to the City of Sweetwater, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sweetwater has become home to thousands of Nicaraguans; and

WHEREAS, Nicaraguans residing in the City of Sweetwater have demonstrated their entrepreneurship and desire to contribute to the community through participation in numerous activities and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sweetwater desired to recognize the contributions made by its Nicaraguan residents; and

WHEREAS, SW 104th Court from West Flagler Street to SW 4th Street is a city street located in the City of Sweetwater; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sweetwater would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 12,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Sweetwater codesignation of SW 104th Court from West Flagler Street to SW 4th Street as “Avenida Nicaragua”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Mayor of the City of Sweetwater, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Sweetwater Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


WHEREAS, the City of Sweetwater wishes to recognize the contributions made by the Nicaraguans who have chosen to live and work in our community these past 14 years:

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 3 day of October, 1994.


