

RESOLUTION NO. R-731-15

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO COLLABORATE WITH THE UNITED STATES SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION TO CONDUCT JOINT COMMUNITY OUTREACH EFFORTS TO INFORM INDIVIDUALS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ABOUT SOCIAL SECURITY SERVICES AVAILABLE ONLINE, LINK THE COUNTY'S WEBSITE TO THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION'S WEBSITE, AND TO REPORT BACK THIS BOARD

WHEREAS, the United States Social Security Administration ("Social Security Administration") provides numerous services to individuals across the nation, including but not limited to financial assistance to retirees; and

WHEREAS, the Social Security Administration's website enables users to create online accounts, to obtain letters verifying Social Security benefits they currently receive, to apply for Social Security benefits, to obtain Social Security statements, to determine current benefit eligibility, and to estimate potential future benefits; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that individuals in Miami-Dade County have the ability to access federal services, such as those provided by the Social Security Administration, for which they are eligible to avoid falling behind the rest of the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1: Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to collaborate with the United States Social Security Administration ("Social Security Administration") to conduct joint community outreach efforts to inform individuals in Miami-Dade County about Social

Security services available online and to link the County's website to the Social Security Administration's website to provide Miami-Dade residents with an opportunity to have better access to the Social Security Administration's services.

Section 2: Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to report back to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Xavier L. Suarez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Daniella Levine Cava** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
