



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE MAY 30, 2015 "2ND ANNUAL 5K ZOO WALK/RUN AND KIDS BASH" SPONSORED BY ONE HUNDRED BLACK MEN OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$325.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 8 FY 2014-15 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, One Hundred Black Men of South Florida, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the May 30, 2015 "2nd Annual 5K Zoo Walk/Run and Kids Bash" in an amount not to exceed \$325.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "2nd Annual 5K Zoo Walk/Run and Kids Bash" is to, among other things, engage in physical activity and provide nutritional education as part of an initiative to promote healthy living; and

WHEREAS, One Hundred Black Men of South Florida, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "2nd Annual 5K Zoo Walk/Run and Kids Bash" is a small event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$325.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 8 FY 2014-15 In-Kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the May


