RESOLUTION NO. R-907-15

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS IN ALL
CONTRACTS FOR THE USE OF THE RONALD REAGAN
EQUESTRIAN CENTER AT TROPICAL PARK REQUIRING
THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE EVENT VENUE BY NAME
IN ALL MARKETING MATERIALS

WHEREAS, the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center (the "Equestrian Center"), located in Tropical Park, is a full-service equestrian facility that hosts more than 36 shows per year; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to the Equestrian Center were constructed at substantial County expense—approximately \$6.3 million—in part with the intention of attracting top-flight agriculture, horse, and cattle events from around the world; and

WHEREAS, one such event was the 2013 CONFEPASO (Confederation of Paso Fino) event, which brought hundreds of horses from many countries in the Caribbean and Central and South America, along with thousands of spectators who viewed the event, in person and via internet streaming; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the CONFEPASO event, the Equestrian Center has hosted a multitude of other events—including the annual Miami International Agriculture, Horse and Cattle Show—that draw animals and people from diverse parts of the world; and

WHEREAS, in connection with those events and similar events of both a larger and smaller scale, the County, through its Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department, enters into agreements for the temporary use of the Equestrian Center with event organizers; and

WHEREAS, in order to raise the global profile of the Equestrian Center; acknowledge the County's substantial contribution to the day-to-day management of and, indeed, the very existence of the Equestrian Center; promote Miami-Dade County as an agricultural center; and

ensure that event organizers come to associate the Equestrian Center with other similar facilities in the world that are suitable for the hosting of national and international agriculture and animal husbandry events, this Board desires that all marketing materials for events taking place at the Equestrian Center prominently acknowledge that the events are taking place at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center at Tropical Park in Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and adopted by this Board as true and correct.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to include in all agreements for the use of the Equestrian Center contractual provisions that ~~[[:(a)-]]¹ require event organizers to include a prominent acknowledgement in any marketing materials produced for events taking place at the Equestrian Center that the event occurred at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center at Tropical Park in Miami-Dade County, Florida ~~[[("Marketing Requirement")]; and (b) provide for the assessment of liquidated damages of \$100.00 for each breach of the Marketing Requirement as an acknowledgement of the fact that damages from the breach of the Marketing Requirement are not readily ascertainable and the aforementioned liquidated damages amount is not grossly disproportionate to the damages reasonably expected to flow from the breach of the Marketing Requirement]]~~.~~

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
