RESOLUTION NO. R-140-16

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SEEK COLLABORATION OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD IN OFFERING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENROLL IN SUMMER VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL CLASSES AND TO REPORT BACK TO THIS BOARD WITHIN 90 DAYS

WHEREAS, vocational and technical classes train students to develop skill sets that help increase students' employability after graduation; and

WHEREAS, the opportunity to enroll in vocational and technical classes during the summer will provide high school students with a constructive use of their spare time; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to help high school students become career-minded from an early age; and

WHEREAS, the opportunity to enroll in summer vocational and technical classes should be available to all high school students; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to partner with the Miami-Dade County School Board to help high school students learn valuable skill sets that will set them on a path of professional development,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to seek collaboration of the Miami-Dade County School Board ("School Board") in offering high school students the opportunity to enroll in summer vocational and technical classes, beginning in 2016.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to report back to this Board with recommendations as to how the County and the School Board may partner in providing high school students with vocational and technical summer classes and to place the completed report on an agenda of this Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65 within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, and the Co-Sponsors are Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava, Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson and Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
