



**Subject:** Resolution Authorizing Construction of Intersection Improvements on Old Cutler Road at SW 184 Street

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## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached Resolution authorizing the construction of intersection improvements on Old Cutler Road at SW 184 Street. The proposed improvements will not detract from the historical features of the road and, in an effort to assure safe travel, will enhance traffic operations for area residents and other users at the intersection.

## SCOPE

The property is located in Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava's District 8.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Palmer Trinity School will proffer the design and construction to complete the required improvements and Miami-Dade County (County) will not be responsible for any costs in connection with same. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact associated with this authorization.

## TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The project will be assigned to Ricardo Gavilan, Project Manager of the Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) Traffic and Engineering Division, who will oversee the review of design approvals. Bassam Moubayed, CFM, Chief of the Construction Division, will monitor the construction phase of this improvement for DTPW.

## BACKGROUND

Section 9-2 of the Miami-Dade County Code (Code) prohibits the widening or expansion of Old Cutler Road from its presently paved right-of-way provided that the Board can permit the limited expansion of Old Cutler Road and its intersections for the purpose of assuring safe travel. Prior to the Board authorizing same, the Code provides that a public hearing must occur with reasonable notice by publication. The Village of Palmetto Bay (Village) has conducted several zoning public hearings regarding the proposed expansion of Palmer Trinity Private School. Based upon recommendations from Palmer Trinity's traffic engineer, and the Village's traffic consultant, as well as comments from area residents, the Village incorporated into its zoning resolutions several conditions requiring roadway improvements to enhance traffic safety.

On August 29, 2012 by Resolution No. 2012-64 and again on September 22, 2014 by Resolution Number 2014-67, the Village, after public hearing, approved the expansion of Palmer Trinity and included as a condition the following traffic mitigation:

*"The applicant shall be responsible for implementing the following mitigation initiatives, as delineated in the David Plummer & Associates Report (Applicant's traffic expert), dated April 22, 2010:*

- a) *Old Cutler Road/ SW 184 Street – Add a Southbound right turn lane; signal phasing adjustments”*

Additionally, DTPW (formerly the Public Works and Waste Management Department) required Palmer Trinity School to comply with the traffic mitigation improvements stated in Village Resolution No. 2012-64 as per a conditional traffic approval provided to the school on June 5, 2014.

In light of the forgoing, and for the purpose of ensuring safe travel, it is in the best interest of the County to authorize the proposed intersection improvements to Old Cutler Road.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION  
OF INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ON OLD CUTLER  
ROAD AT SW 184 STREET

**WHEREAS**, Section 9-2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County prohibits the widening or expansion of Old Cutler Road from its presently paved right-of-way except for the purpose of assuring safe travel; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 9-2 of the Code permits the Board of County Commissioners to permit the limited expansion of intersections on said Old Cutler Road for purposes of assuring safe travel on Old Cutler Road, after public hearing, with reasonable notice by newspaper publication; and

**WHEREAS**, safe travel along Old Cutler Road will require the construction of a southbound right turn lane at the intersection of Old Cutler Road with SW 184 Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has conducted a public hearing as required by Section 9-2 of the Code, and desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and are approved.

**Section 2.** This Board finds that the expansion of Old Cutler Road as set forth in the accompanying memorandum, is necessary in an effort to assure safe travel along Old Cutler Road.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Daniella Levine Cava**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey M. Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
