



RESOLUTION NO. R-510-16

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ANALYZE THE FEASIBILITY OF IDENTIFYING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE SOURCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING THE RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP PROGRAM IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO ADDITIONAL GRADE LEVELS AND TO PROVIDE A REPORT ON SAME WITHIN 120 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION AND SHALL PLACE THE COMPLETED REPORT ON AN AGENDA OF THE BOARD, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 14-65

**WHEREAS**, in 2013, the Miami-Dade County Animal Services Department launched the Responsible Pet Ownership Curriculum in Miami-Dade County schools for elementary school students in third, fourth and fifth grade; and

**WHEREAS**, this program promotes responsible pet ownership and at the same time stimulates students to develop strong character traits, while caring for pets; and

**WHEREAS**, this program currently reaches over 89,000 students; and

**WHEREAS**, this program has been extremely successful since it was implemented; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission believes that expanding this program to junior high and high school students will benefit additional students, as well as increase public awareness about Animal Service Department's success in saving animals; and

**WHEREAS**, Animal Service Department does not currently have the funding resources to expand this program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission believes that identifying additional funding from any legally available source to help ASD expand this program would benefit the County and the community by teaching additional students and helping to spread awareness about ASD's success in saving animals,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee is directed to analyze the feasibility of identifying additional funding from any legally available source for the purpose of expanding the Responsible Pet Ownership Curriculum in Miami-Dade County schools to additional grade levels and to provide a report on same. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee is directed to include in said report recommendations regarding the source of this additional funding. Further, the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee is directed to complete said report within 120 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board, pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, and the Co-Sponsors are Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and Commissioner Sally A. Heyman.

It was offered by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
