



RESOLUTION NO. R-301-16

RESOLUTION CALLING SPECIAL ELECTION IN PROPOSED SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO QUALIFIED ELECTORS RESIDING IN SKY LAKE GARDENS CONDO NO. 4 STREET LIGHTING SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT, FOR THEIR APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL, ORDINANCE NO. CREATING AND ESTABLISHING SAID DISTRICT PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-3(f), CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

**WHEREAS**, on April 5, 2016, this Board passed Ordinance No. 16-35 creating and establishing Sky Lake Gardens Condo No. 4 Street Lighting Special Taxing District; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 18-3(f) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as amended, presently provides that an ordinance creating and establishing such a special taxing district shall take effect when approved by a majority vote of the qualified electors residing in the district voting at an election to be called by the Board and noticed and conducted in such manner as the Board shall by resolution determine,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** In accordance with the provisions of Section 18-3(f) of the Code of Miami Dade County, Florida, a special election is hereby called and shall be held within the boundaries of the proposed Sky Lake Gardens Condo No. 4 Street Lighting Special Taxing District, Miami-Dade County, Florida, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing in the said district, for their approval or disapproval, Ordinance No. 16-35 entitled:

ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A  
SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT IN MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY, FLORIDA KNOWN AND DESCRIBED AS  
SKY LAKE GARDENS CONDO NO. 4 STREET  
LIGHTING SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF  
CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY, FLORIDA

**Section 2.** Notice of such special election shall be published in accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

**Section 3.** The results of such special election shall be determined by a majority of the qualified electors residing in the Sky Lake Gardens Condo No. 4 Street Lighting Special Taxing District voting at such special election. All qualified electors residing in the Sky Lake Gardens Condo No. 4 Street Lighting Special Taxing District shall be entitled to vote at said special election.

**Section 4.** The County registration books shall remain open at the Office of the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections until April 11, 2016 at which date the registration books shall close in accordance with the provisions of the general election laws.

**Section 5.** Mailed ballots, as prescribed by the Code of Miami-Dade County, shall be used in this special election. The Supervisor of Elections shall cause such ballots to be sent by mail to all qualified electors residing in said district, at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the date of said special election.

**Section 6.** The special election shall be held on May 10, 2016. All marked ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. on the day of said election.

**Section 7.** The question which shall appear on the ballot shall be in substantially the following form:

Shall a special taxing district known and designated as the Sky Lake Gardens Condo No. 4 Street Lighting Special Taxing District be created and established as provided for in County Ordinance No.

**Section 8.** This special election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the County Code and other applicable provisions of the general laws relating to special elections. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee, the Finance Director, the Supervisor of Elections, and the Clerk of the County Commission are hereby authorized and directed to take all appropriate actions necessary to carry into effect and accomplish the provisions of this Resolution.

**Section 9.** This special election shall be canvassed by the County Canvassing Board as provided under the election laws of this State, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.07 of the Home Rule Charter.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Jean Monestime** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
