Subject: Resolution Ratifying the Action Related to Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) ratify the action of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee as authorized under Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code related to Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department's Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance (WASD Acceleration Ordinance) for capital projects and related goods and services identified below and in Exhibit A, as attached.

Consent Decree and Multi-Year Capital Plan Projects

Item 1 is a recommendation for approval to establish a prequalification pool for RTQ-00298: Trenchless Pipe Installation and Pipe Rehabilitation Services. This item ratifies the establishment of a prequalification pool for a total amount of up to \$85,000,000.00, with a total term of eight (8) years for work on Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department Consent Decree and Multi-Year Capital Plan projects. This prequalification pool consists of two groups: (1) new pipe installation and (2) trenchless rehabilitation of existing pipes. Seventeen (17) vendors responded to the solicitation. Additional qualified vendors may be added to the pre-qualification pool during the term of the contract.

Delegation of Authority

The Board is delegating to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee the authority to (a) solicit pricing and award contracts up to the aggregate amount of the allocation authorized by the Board, (b) exercise all provisions of the solicitation documents and any resulting contracts pursuant to Sections 2-8.1 and 2-8.2.12 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and (c) add vendors to the prequalification pool at any time, subject to Board ratification on a bi-annual basis.

Scope

The Commission districts of the project locations are noted on Exhibit A. The goods and services contracts awarded through WASD's Acceleration Ordinance have a countywide impact.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact and funding source for this item are detailed on Exhibit A and the other accompanying attachments.

Track Record/Monitoring

WASD's Deputy Director, Hardeep Anand, will oversee the implementation of this project.

Background

On September 3, 2014, the Board approved Ordinance No. 14-77 authorizing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to award contracts for funded capital projects and related goods and services and to accelerate the approval of WASD's: 1) Consent Decree projects, and 2) projects identified in WASD's

Multi-Year Capital Plan's Capital Improvements Program, without the need for prior Board approval but subject to ratification by the Board.



Subject: Recommendation for Approval to Establish a Pre-Qualification Pool: Trenchless Pipe Installation and Pipe Rehabilitation Services

RECOMMENDATION

Pursuant to the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance as seen in Section 2-8.2.12 of the County Code, it is recommended that the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee approve the establishment of a pre-qualification pool under *Request to Qualify No. RTQ-00298, Trenchless Pipe Installation and Pipe Rehabilitation Services*. In accordance with the Acceleration Ordinance, the establishment of this pool is subject to ratification by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) at the Board's next available meeting.

POOL NUMBER: RTQ-00298

POOL TITLE: Trenchless Pipe Installation and Pipe Rehabilitation Services Pre-qualification

TERM: Eight (8) years

METHOD OF AWARD: To all responsive, responsible vendors meeting the pre-qualification requirements as specified in the solicitation for participation in future spot market competitions.

PRIOR POOL NUMBER, AMOUNT AND TERM: None

POOL AMOUNT: \$85,000,000

BACKGROUND

A Request to Qualify (RTQ) was issued under full and open competition on September 25, 2015 to establish a prequalification pool to obtain trenchless pipe installation and pipe rehabilitation services for the Water and Sewer Department. The pool has two (2) groups: (1) New Pipe Installation and (2) Trenchless Rehabilitation of Existing Pipes. The Water and Sewer Department will rely on the pool to purchase installation and/or rehabilitation services for its water, sanitary sewer gravity and drainage pipes, sanitary sewer force mains and culverts. Vendors will apply trenchless technology (i.e., minimally disruptive subsurface construction work) in delivering the services.

Seventeen vendors responded to the solicitation, one (1) of which was a "No Bid." The vendors listed in the following table satisfied the pre-qualification criteria. Additional qualified vendors may be added to the pool during the term of the RTQ.





RESOLUTION RATIFYING ESTABLISHMENT OF A PREQUALIFICATION POOL BY THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE FOR RTQ-00298: TRENCHLESS PIPE INSTALLATION AND PIPE REHABILITATION SERVICES IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$85,000,000.00 FOR A TOTAL TERM OF EIGHT (8) YEARS PURSUANT TO MIAMI-DADE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT'S CONSENT DECREE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS ACCELERATION ORDINANCE, SECTION 2-8.2.12 OF THE COUNTY CODE; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SOLICIT PRICING, AWARD CONTRACTS, EXERCISE ALL PROVISIONS OF THE SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS AND ANY RESULTING CONTRACTS PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-8.1 AND 2.8.2.12 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND TO ADD VENDORS TO THE POOL AT ANY TIME, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE BOARD ON A BI-ANNUAL BASIS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board ratifies, pursuant to Section 2-8.2.12 of the County Code, the establishment of a prequalification pool by the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee for RTQ-00298: Trenchless Pipe Installation and Pipe Rehabilitation Services Pre-qualification, attached to the accompanying memorandum as Exhibit B, for a total amount of up to \$85,000,000.00 with a total term of eight years for work on Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department Consent Decree and Multi-Year Capital Plan Projects; and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to (a) solicit pricing and award contracts up to the aggregate amount of the allocation authorized by the Board, (b)
