## RESOLUTION NO. R-653-16

RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT, THE TERM LIMIT IMPOSED ON MAGGIE GONZALEZ AND REAPPOINTING HER TO THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR ANOTHER TERM

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") enacted Ordinance No. 10-06, amending Chapter 2, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, to permit the waiver of term limits for county board members; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, no board member shall serve for more than eight consecutive years on a board, unless waived by a two-thirds vote of the members present of the Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-191.5 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, members of the Housing Finance Authority of Miami-Dade County have terms of four years; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limits and reappoint Maggie Gonzalez to the Housing Finance Authority of Miami-Dade County for another four year term,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board by a two-thirds vote of Board members present, waives the eight year term limit restriction for Maggie Gonzalez and reappoints her to an additional four year term on the Housing Finance Authority of Miami-Dade County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
