

RESOLUTION NO. R-341-16

RESOLUTION DECLARING SEVEN COMPUTER MONITORS SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING THEIR DONATION TO WECOUNT!, INC; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATION AGREEMENT, TO EXERCISE ANY AND ALL OTHER RIGHTS CONFERRED THEREIN AND TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE FOREGOING

**WHEREAS**, the monitors described below are owned by Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the monitors are obsolete, and their continued usage by Miami-Dade County is uneconomical and inefficient and the monitors serve no useful purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Wecount!, Inc., (the "Donee") desires to use the monitors only within Miami-Dade County to enhance its ability to provide services to its constituents, for the purpose outlined in the attached community based organization agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Donee is a private non-profit agency as defined in Section 273.01(3) of the Florida Statutes, and is exempt from federal income taxation by virtue of Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Donee is an eligible community based organization, as defined in Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County's Internal Services Department has complied with the requirements of Section 2-11.2.1, by offering the monitors to other Miami-Dade County departments and agencies, none of which accepted the monitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the monitors are eligible for donation under Section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** This Board declares the following monitors, with the listed residual value and other characteristics, to be surplus pursuant to Section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County:

**Section 2.** This Board authorizes donation of the monitors to the Donee, and authorizes the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to execute the community based organization agreement in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference and to exercise any and all other rights conferred therein.

The Donee shall take possession of the monitors within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution. Donee shall be responsible for any and all costs of transferring the monitors. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall and is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 3.** If, for any reason, the donee fails to take possession of the monitors within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the monitors shall remain with the County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



## Community Based Organization Donation Agreement

This agreement is entered into between Miami-Dade County (hereafter "County") and WeCount!, Inc. (hereafter "Donee") as follows:

For and in Consideration of the County donating 7 computer monitors (1. Dell, 11 ½" x 14 ¼", Serial # KR-07R477-35830-27A-00HD; 2. Dell, 11 ½" x 14 ¼", Serial # KR-07R477-35830-27A-04X1; 3. Dell, 10 ½" x 13 ½", Serial # CN-0PM372-72872-78L-1381; 4. Dell, 10 ½" x 13 ½", Serial # CN-0WH318-72872-67D-EA7I; 5. Dell, 10 ½" x 13 ½", Serial # CN-0WH317-72872-75P-OU8L; 6. Dell, 10 ¾" x 13 3/8", Serial # BN68-00171A-00; 7. Princeton, 9" x 12", Serial # JCCD2100322) to Donee, and Donee agreeing to the use and as described herein: for computer lab for use by community members and for free computer literacy classes AS IS,

Donee certifies that it is a not-for-profit agency, group, organization, society, association, corporation, partnership or individual that provides a community service designed to improve or enhance the well-being of the community of Miami-Dade County at large or to improve or enhance the well-being of certain individuals within this community that have special needs.

Donee agrees that it shall predominantly utilize the donated surplus property for the intended use specified in section no. 5 of the "Surplus Property Allocation Application", attached hereto. (Attachment A) Moreover, this Community Based Organization (CBO) shall not resell or otherwise dispose of or transfer such property without prior County approval for a period of not less than three (3) years from the date of receipt of the surplus property. This three (3) year requirement may be waived administratively by the Mayor or designee upon showing that it is in the best interest of Miami Dade County. Upon the disposal of such property, Donee agrees to notify Miami Dade County. Upon the failure of the Donee to use the property as set forth in the "Surplus Property Allocation Application", or upon the Donee's attempt to dispose of or transfer the property prior to the expiration of the three (3) year period set forth herein, title to the surplus property shall immediately revert to the County and Donee shall immediately return possession of the property to the County.

The Donee agrees that it shall indemnify and hold harmless Miami Dade County, and its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities et.al. from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorney's fees and costs of defense, which the County or its officers, employees, agents or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to or resulting from the transfer of ownership, maintenance or use of the donated property or by subsequent acts by the Donee, its agents, employees, et.al., and/or the performance of this Agreement by the Donee or its employees, agents, servants, partners, principals. The Donee shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith, and shall investigate and

defend all claims, suits or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the County, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may issue thereon.

"According to section 2-1076 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, Miami-Dade County has established the Office of the Inspector General which may, on a random basis, perform audits, inspections, and reviews of all County contracts. This audit is separate and apart from any other audit by the County."


