



RESOLUTION NO. R-339-16

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY
CODESIGNATION OF SW 212TH STREET BETWEEN SW
85TH AVENUE AND SW 87TH AVENUE AS "TIGER SHARK
WAY"

WHEREAS, Cutler Bay Senior High School, home of the Tiger Sharks, is a new high school located on SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Cutler Bay Senior High School's first graduating class will celebrate their graduation this year; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2015, Cutler Bay Senior High School's Student Government Association formally requested through the Town's Youth Council Committee that SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue be codesignated as "Tiger Shark Way"; and

WHEREAS, at its October 28, 2015 meeting, the Town's Youth Council Committee unanimously approved Cutler Bay Senior High School's Student Government Association's codesignation request; and

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2016, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Cutler Bay (hereinafter the Cutler Bay Town Council) adopted Resolution No. 16-05, which requested that the County rename SW 212th Street, between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue as "Tiger Shark Way", a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Cutler Bay Town Council indicated in Resolution No. 16-05 that the codesignation of SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue as “Tiger Shark Way” would create a sense of community and school pride amongst the students and future alumni of Cutler Bay Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, it was later determined that the portion of SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue is a city street, rather than a County road; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Cutler Bay Town Council will adopt a resolution codesignating SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue as “Tiger Shark Way” at its May 18, 2016 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cutler Bay would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms and to have the signage in place for Cutler Bay Senior High School’s first graduation on June 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the Town of Cutler Bay codesignation of SW 212th Street between SW 85th Avenue and SW 87th Avenue as “Tiger Shark Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor, Town Council and Town Manager of the Town of Cutler Bay, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Miami-Dade Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava. It was offered by Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 16-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, FORMALLY REQUESTING THAT THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RENAME S.W. 212 STREET BETWEEN S.W. 85 AVENUE TO S.W. 87 AVENUE TO TIGER SHARK WAY; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE TOWN MANAGER AND/OR DELEGATE TO ADVOCATE FOR SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2013, the Town of Cutler Bay (the "Town") Town Council adopted Resolution No. 13-86 urging the Miami-Dade County School Board to support the request from the Town's Youth Council Committee to rename Cutler Bay Schools; and

WHEREAS, Town staff worked diligently with Miami-Dade County School Board staff, the District's Educational Facilities Renaming Committee and Board Member Dr. Larry Feldman to rename Cutler Bay Academy of Advanced Studies - Centennial Campus to Cutler Bay Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2015, the Miami-Dade County School Board approved the school renaming to Cutler Bay Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, the Cutler Bay Senior High School's Student Government Association formally requested through the Town's Youth Council Committee to rename S.W. 212 Street (from S.W. 85 Avenue to S.W. 87 Avenue) Tiger Shark Way; and

WHEREAS, the Town's Youth Council Committee unanimously approved the street renaming request during its meeting on October 28, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council believe that renaming portions of S.W. 212 Street to Tiger Shark Way, will create a sense of both community and school pride amongst the students and future alumni of Cutler Bay Senior High School.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Recitals. The above Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Request. The Town Council hereby requests that the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners consider renaming a portion of S.W. 212 Street (from S.W. 85 Avenue to S.W. 87 Avenue) to Tiger Shark Way.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Manager. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, including, but not limited to, the execution of any required documents on the behalf of the Town that will bring the aforementioned goal to fruition.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


