



Subject: Resolution Declaring the Acquisition of the Designated Property Known as Parcel 108 for Right-of-Way Needed for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Improvements to SW 137 Avenue From US-1 to SW 200 Street to be a Public Necessity; Authorizing the County Mayor or the County Mayor's Designee and Accomplish Acquisition of the Subject Property in Fee Simple By Purchase at Appraised Value; Superseding Resolution R-529-13; and Authorizing the use of People's Transportation Plan Funds

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution superseding the previously adopted Resolution No. R-529-13 dated July 2, 2013 authorizing the acquisition of Parcel 108 needed for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Improvements to SW 137 Avenue, from US-1 to SW 200 Street, which provides for the acquisition of said Parcel 108, with a reduced area of needed right-of-way to reflect a previous dedication of right-of-way. Proceeds from People's Transportation Plan Bond proceeds will be used to fund this project, therefore approval by the Board and the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

Said Resolution is placed for committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This item may only be considered by the Board if the CITT has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration, or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this item. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this item, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

SCOPE

The impact of this project is countywide; however, it is located within Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava's District 8.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for the right-of-way acquisition, design, and construction of this Project is from People's Transportation Plan bond proceeds, and may be supplemented by other eligible funding sources. Funding is programmed within the adopted FY2015-16 Adopted Budget and Multi-Year Capital Plan (Project 607930). The initial acquisition cost has been budgeted and no additional fiscal impacts are expected; however, in the event of litigation the ultimate acquisition cost would be subject to a future ruling by the Court.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is the entity overseeing this project and the responsible person for monitoring this acquisition project is Mr. Francisco Fernandez, Chief Real Estate Officer of the Right-of-Way Division.

BACKGROUND

DTPW has programmed the construction of SW 137 Avenue as part of the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street. The proposed project includes roadway expansion, beautification and improvements consisting of a new two-lane road with sidewalks, curb and gutter, a continuous storm drain system, signalization, pavement markings and signage, street lighting, bicycle facilities, a bridge crossing over one (1) canal, and a culvert for a second canal.

The area to be acquired by Miami-Dade County was reduced due to DTPW Engineering staff discovering that portions of the proposed acquisition area had been previously dedicated in the 1940's and 1950's. This discovery occurred during title work prior to the closing for the purchase of said parcel. The reduced area remains necessary for the proposed roadway improvements, and is legally described in "Exhibit A" and illustrated on the parcel location map in "Exhibit B" all attached herewith.

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF DESIGNATED PROPERTY KNOWN AS PARCEL 108 FOR THE PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN (PTP) PROJECT ENTITLED IMPROVEMENTS ON SW 137 AVENUE FROM US-1 TO SW 200 STREET, TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE AND THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO ACCOMPLISH ACQUISITION OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN FEE SIMPLE, BY DONATION, PURCHASE AT VALUES ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISALS OR TAX ASSESSED VALUE, WHICHEVER IS HIGHER, TOGETHER WITH REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 73.091 AND 73.092, FLORIDA STATUTES, OR BY EMINENT DOMAIN COURT PROCEEDING INCLUDING DECLARATIONS OF TAKING, AS NECESSARY; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SURTAX FUNDS; RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. R-529-13

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds and declares that the acquisition of Parcel 108, as legally described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, is necessary to accomplish the construction for the project entitled improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US- 1 to SW 200 Street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board ratifies and adopts the matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. This Board finds and declares that the acquisition of the subject parcel, as legally described in “Exhibit A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is needed for the public purpose of improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street.

Section 3. This Board authorizes and directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee and County Attorney to employ appraisers, review appraisers and expert witnesses, to obtain required environmental audits and to take any action to acquire the subject parcel, as legally described in “Exhibit A” in fee simple, including any businesses thereon, either by donation, purchase at values established by appraisals or tax assessed value whichever is the higher of the two, together with reasonable attorney’s fees, expert fees and costs pursuant to Chapter 73.091 and 73.092, Florida Statutes, or eminent domain court proceedings including a declaration of taking as necessary for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County and authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds.

Section 4. Pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, this Board direct the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to record the instruments of conveyance accepted herein in the Public Record of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and to provide a recorded copy of the instrument to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of said instrument; and directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy together with this resolution.

Section 5. This Resolution shall supersede Resolution R-529-13, which is hereby rescinded and replaced herewith.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:




