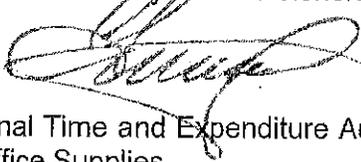

**Subject:** Request for Additional Time and Expenditure Authority to Prequalification Pool  
 No. 6712-5/15-5, Office Supplies

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize additional time of one (1) year and increased spending authority of \$1,579,000 to *Prequalification Pool No. 6712-5/15-5, Office Supplies*, for the Internal Services Department. This pool was originally established in January 2006 by the Board for a five-year term with five (5), one-year options to renew and is used by the Internal Services Department to provide various office supplies and related products for County departments upon request.

A replacement solicitation for office supplies was issued to determine whether awarding to one (1) vendor rather than using the pool would reduce costs to the County and offer enhanced service delivery. The solicitation results are currently under review and a recommendation to the Board is forthcoming. The additional time and allocation for this pool is needed to cover departmental requirements while an assessment of the best long-term solution for the acquisition of office supplies countywide is completed.

**Scope**

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

**Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

This pool, which is in its fifth option to renew, expires on July 31, 2016. The modified allocation reflects a six-month administrative extension. The requested additional allocation of \$1,579,000 is based on anticipated usage during the one-year extension period and results in a modified allocation of \$3,947,500 as set forth below. If this request is approved, the cumulative value of this pool will be \$28,105,500 for 11 years.

**Track Record/Monitor**

Allan M. Garcia of the Internal Services Department is the Procurement Contracting Officer.

**Delegated Authority**

There is no additional delegation of authority sought in this item as the authority to solicit pricing and award contracts up to an aggregate amount of the allocation authorized by the Board, exercise all provisions of the solicitation documents and any resulting contracts pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38, and add vendors to the pool at any time, subject to ratification by the Board on a bi-annual basis, was granted when the pool was established by the Board.

**Pre-Qualified Vendors**

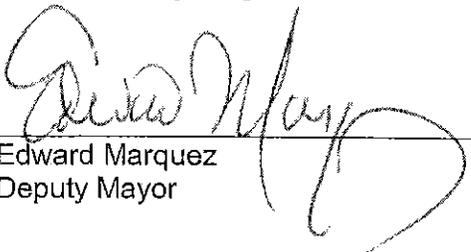
See Attachment No. 1, Vendor Table. There are currently 18 pre-qualified vendors, of which 11 have a local office.

**Due Diligence**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12, due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and review of performance and compliance issues. The lists referenced include convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There are no adverse findings relating to contractor responsibility.

**Applicable Ordinances and Contract Measures**

- The two (2) percent User Access Program provision applies.
- The Small Business Enterprise Bid Preference and Local Preference Ordinances will be applied at the time of spot market competition.

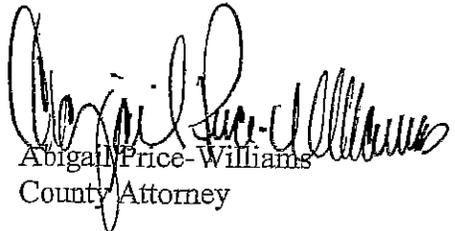

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL TIME OF ONE-YEAR AND ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY IN A TOTAL AMOUNT UP TO \$1,579,000.00 FOR PREQUALIFICATION POOL NO. 6712-5/15-5 FOR PURCHASE OF OFFICE SUPPLIES FOR THE INTERNAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SOLICIT PRICING, AWARD CONTRACTS, EXERCISE ALL PROVISIONS OF THE SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS AND ANY RESULTING CONTRACTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-8.1 OF THE COUNTY CODE AND IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-38, AND ADD VENDORS TO THE POOL AT ANY TIME, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE BOARD ON A BI-ANNUAL BASIS

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board authorizes additional time of one-year and additional expenditure authority in an amount up to \$1,579,000.00 for Prequalification Pool No. 6712-5/15-5 for the purchase of office supplies for the Internal Services Department and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to solicit pricing, award contracts, exercise all provisions of the solicitation documents and any resulting contracts pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38, and add vendors to the pool at any time, subject to ratification by the Board on a bi-annual basis. A copy of the solicitation document and the contracts once awarded are on file with and available upon request from the Internal Services Department, Procurement Management Services Division.
